All employees that operate a TMA must as a Duty of Care and Chain of Responsibility receive adequate training to allow the operator to safely be able to conduct their duties and work commitments, allowing employers some piece of mind by their operators being Nationally Accredited by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO).

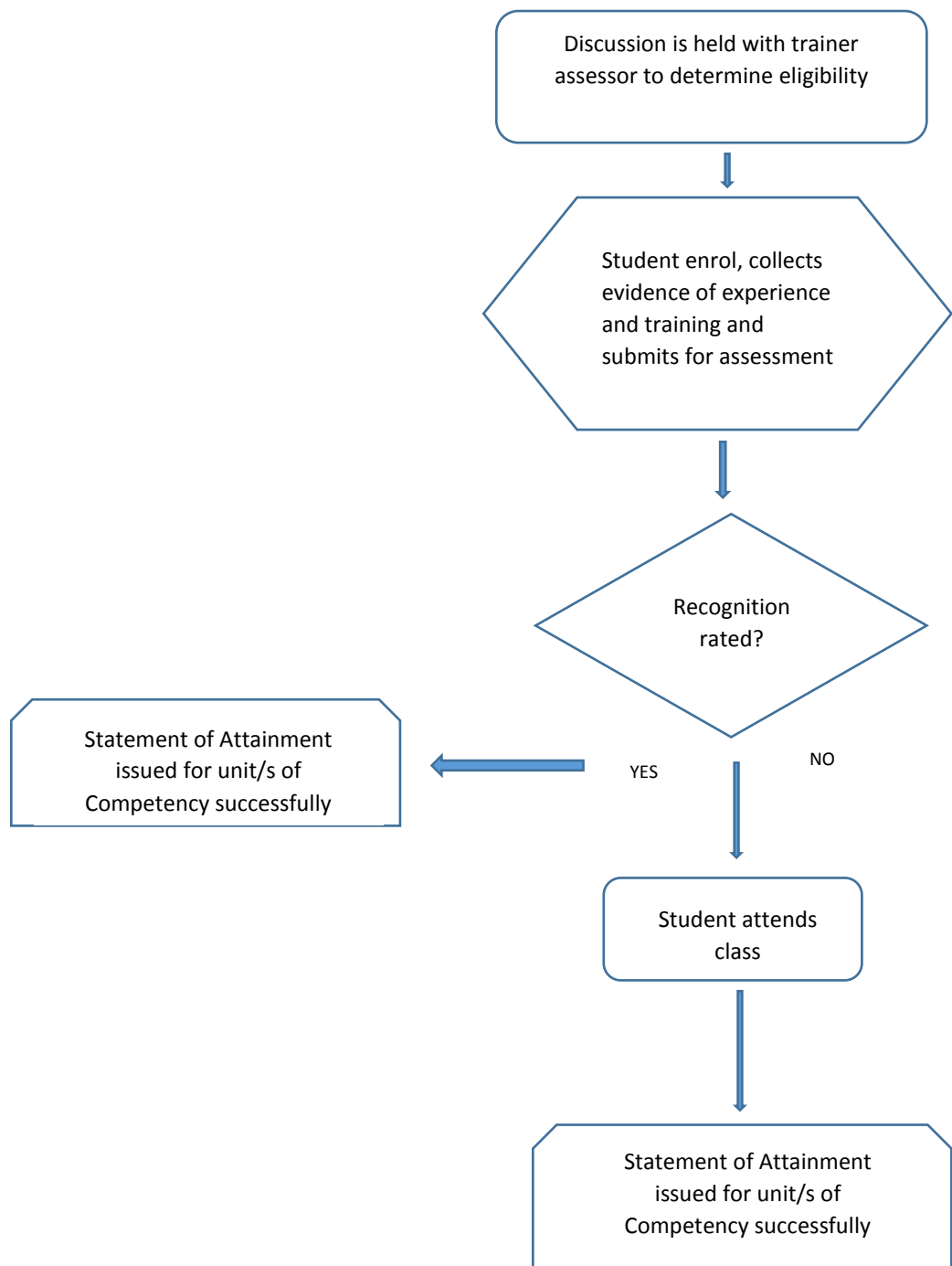
