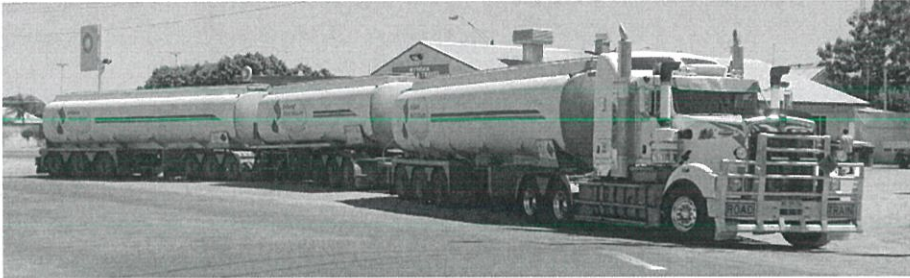




# **DANGEROUS GOODS** **TRAINING**



## **Dangerous Goods Licence**

### **Summary**

This course is for persons who wish or are required by law to obtain the Dangerous Goods Driver's Licence or are required to renew their Dangerous Goods Driver's Licence. This course provides knowledge of the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods legislation and the Australian Dangerous Goods Code (ADG7) and the responsibilities associated with transporting dangerous or hazardous cargo by road. A Dangerous Goods Driver's Licence is only required for transport of Dangerous Goods in the following cases:

- In a receptacle with a capacity of more than 500L,
- If there are more than 500Kg in a single receptacle,
- In the case of intermediate bulk containers (IBC's), where the total capacity IBC's is more than 3,000L or where any IBC is filled or emptied while on the vehicle

### **Duration:**

Compulsory 2 Day course.

### **Licence Application Requirements**

To drive a licenced Dangerous Goods Vehicle you must hold a Dangerous Goods Driver's Licence. Licences are now valid for 5 years.

To apply for a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence you need to:

- Complete the accredited training course provided by Trans-Plant Training P/L
- Be Medical fit:
  - Complete the required medical Form
- Have satisfactory driving history:
  - You must include an RMS Driving history report that has been issued within the

last 6 months, obtained by an RMS office **NOT** online, this must have the RMS stamp on driving history

- Provide Identification:
  - 2 passport size photographs
  - Photocopy of front & back of your Vehicle Drivers Licence, your Vehicles Drivers Licence must be presented to the trainer on training day
  
- Application Forms completed and Trans-Plant Training P/L will forward application to EPA for processing for your Dangerous Goods Licence
