

Trans-Plant Training COVID Policy

Trans-plant Training (TPT) is responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, following NSW and Commonwealth Government advice. This announcement is to provide up-to-date information about what we're doing to keep our community safe.

Fully vaccinated staff, trainers, and students can come to Burwood, Liverpool, Parramatta and Penrith campuses - provided they have proof of vaccination or a medical exemption and comply with other COVID safe requirements. For staff, trainers and students don't have vaccination certificate, it is compulsory to show TPT staff their negative Covid-19 test result within 3 days to the commencement of the class.

Accessing the campus

Before you come to campus, please follow [NSW Health advice about self-isolation and testing](#). If you have even the mildest of symptoms, get tested and stay home until you receive a negative result.

All students accessing the campus are required to follow the restrictions below according to NSW Health and SafeWork NSW:

- All students who are attending their place of study and show evidence of clearance to our reception staff upon entry – for all student's safety purposes.
- All students prior to entering the college door MUST do a COVID-19 QR code check in, and show the reception their check in
- All students MUST always wear masks within the college premises
- All students MUST always sanitise their hands
- All students MUST keep their distance from other patrons within the college, and follow sign where seating is allocated students are not permitted to move any already place chairs and desks.
- Any student that has any signs of COVID symptoms and/or feel unwell, you MUST stay home and contact the college reception and notify that you are unable to attend and reschedule your course for a later date.
